POP-IN AND PICKUP The Sun City and Fairway Libraries started their Pop-in and Pickup service on October 5th. While in the library, customers can pick up holds, handle library account needs, and browse a limited selection of the library's collection. Inperson events, computers and recorder kiosks will not be available at this time. Online events and Book-A-Librarian will still be available. In early November, MCLD hopes to open with full operating hours and library services, with additional policies and safety precautions in place. The safety of all who enjoy are libraries is our top priority so this timeline is subject to change based on data from the CDC and Maricopa County Department of Public health.
