The national pen-pal program has expanded to local nursing homes, and to cancer patients. Currently, they are working with five nursing homes in the Sun City, Surprise, and Glendale area,

and are looking to add more as they get more volunteers.

The letters are then forwarded to local nursing homes and cancer patients nationally. Feel free to send as many letters as you'd like to the above address.

The letters can be whatever length writers want. Personalized and cheerful letters go a long way in making the recipients day! Writers can also give some facts about themselves! Readers love hearing stories. Ask them questions, and include some personal facts; so, if the residents decide to write back, they can answer them.
