

LIBRARY SUPPORT At the Friends September Board meeting, the Board approved an expenditure of \$1,870 to improve the lighting in the hallway to the Fairway Library.

The Board also approved the funds for the purchase of magnifiers. They will be used as promotional hand-outs at Friends presentations, and be available free to Library patrons who need them.

Funds for flash drives for Library patrons have been used to order more flash drives. The flash drives are also used as promotional items.

FRIENDS BYLAW ADJUSTMENTS

The Friends Board of Directors approved one Bylaw adjustment and postponed another one until the next meeting. Approved was a clarification

in who can vote in Board meetings. Nothing will change in Board operations; the current language was unclear.

Postponed to the next meeting was a proposal to change the Board members term duration from six years to three years with an option to one more three year term. The Board wanted to clarify the language before approval.






WITH MY WIFE."


